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
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



A Session on the Role and Functions of the Federal Tax Ombudsman Secretariat 26 August 2022



An Awareness Session was conducted on the role and functions of the Federal Tax Ombudsman (FTO). Advisor to FTO Regional Secretariat Abbottabad, Muhammad Majid Qureshi visited COMSATS University Abbottabad Campus, on 26 August 2022. Awareness sessions with the faculty and administrative staff regarding the role, significance, and impact of FTO remained progressive and interactive.

Speaking at the session, Advisor to FTO Regional Secretariat Abbottabad, Muhammad Majid Qureshi said that in 1983, the office of Wafaqi Mohtasib (Ombudsman)'s Secretariat was created to check maladministration in federal departments. Later, to alleviate taxpayers' problems and difficulties and to

enhance the ease of doing business, the institution of FTO was established in the year 2000 to address taxpayer's grievances promptly and without any hassles, an effective redressal system was vital. Since its inception, the FTO has provided relief to thousands of aggrieved taxpayers and has played a significant role in addressing the prevalent maladministration in the taxation system.

The audience was enlightened regarding the role of FTO in providing justice to taxpayers. The complaints being registered against the taxation department are being disposed of within 48 days, as prompt redressal of complaints is the basic right of the taxpayers and the basic motive of FTO.

Seminar on International Perspective of Academic Research Department of Management Sciences 7 December 2022

The seminar on International Perspective of Academic Research was organized by the Management Sciences Department for the MS Students on 7 December, 2022.

The Guest Speaker was Dr Kamran Shafiq Hashmi from the

University of Southern Queensland (USQ), Australia. Dr Kamran is a lecturer of Project Management at the Business School. He received his Ph.D. in management from the University of Queensland, Australia. His research



interests include stakeholder engagement, sustainability, and project management. His current research focuses on community engagement in post-disaster reconstruction initiatives, and his work has been published in reputed international journals. He has characterized the facilitators and barriers to community participation, developed novel methodologies to measure variances in stakeholder salience, and introduced a new stakeholder typology. He

has extensive experience working across cultures on projects and assignments funded by international donor agencies in developing countries. Before joining USQ, Dr Kamran was working at the University of Queensland, Brisbane, Australia, and COMSATS University, Islamabad, Pakistan. His ongoing research concerns indigenous communities' role in sustainable development activities, with a special emphasis on marginalized groups.






